**Notes:**

1. A discrepancy was identified on 5/17/2011 for Calendar Year 2009. It appears that the total number of admission for Yr. 2009 indicating 491, was not accurate – due to clerical error or other factors, e.g. client admissions “not” being keyed into the database, shortage of staff, etc. This discrepancy was identified when the Drug Profile [Table 2] of “clients assessed” was higher than the total number of admissions for the year, as identified in the Calendar Year Admissions Profile [Table 1].

2. On 6/9/2011 – Other errors were identified for Calendar Year 2000, 2003, 2007, and 2010, due to duplicate records – keyed in by DSS. Prior admission totals reflected 429, 506, 745 and 476 respectively. **Corrected changes are now reflected in Table I, as of 6/9/11.**
3. Please note that the changes in the “1<sup>st</sup> client contact” or the “2<sup>nd</sup> or more contacts” may have also changed, for Calendar Year 2000, 2003, 2007, and 2010. In Year 2007, the total remained the same, but the client contacts changed from 313 / 432 respectively to current numbers: 312 / 433.
4. Please take note as well that the recidivism rates on all 4 years (2000, 2003, 2007 and 2010) have been changed. Prior percentages on 5/17/11 were: 49.88%, 54.74% 57.99% and 61.97% respectively. **Corrected changes are now reflected on the Table I, as of 6/9/11.**
5. *(Please note that in 2009, the Admissions Database was being keyed in by the Division of Special Services(DSS). The Client Admission database is currently being handled by Counseling / Case Management Unit, under the Division of Youth Development.)*
